TEXT OF PROPOSED REGULATIONS

Title 15. Crime Prevention and Corrections
Division 8.0 California Prison Industry Authority
Chapter 1, Article 6, Personnel

8122. Employee Prohibition on Use of Nonpublic Information at Auctions

(a) An employee shall not engage in a financial transaction involving a CALPIA auction using nonpublic information, nor allow the improper use of nonpublic information to further that employee's own private interest or that of another, whether through advice or recommendation, or by knowing unauthorized disclosure.

(b) For purposes of this section, nonpublic information is information that the employee gains by reason of state employment and that this employee knows or reasonably should know has not been made available to the general public. It includes information that this employee knows or reasonably should know:

- (1) Is routinely exempt from disclosure under the California Public Records Act §
 6250 et seq., or otherwise protected from disclosure by statute, Executive order or regulation;
- (2) Is designated as confidential by an agency; or
- (3) Has not actually been disseminated to the general public and is not

authorized to be made available to the public on request.
